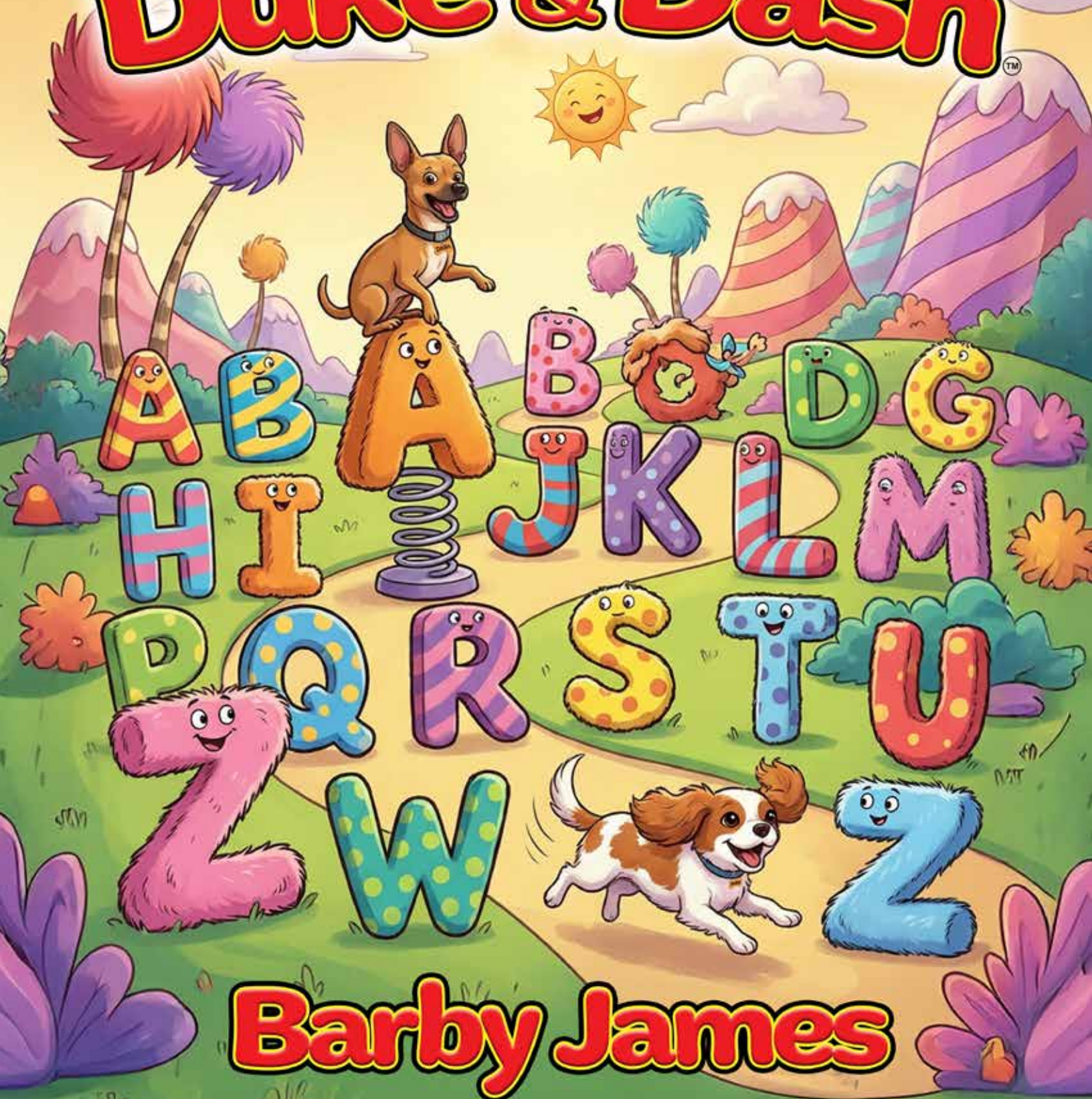

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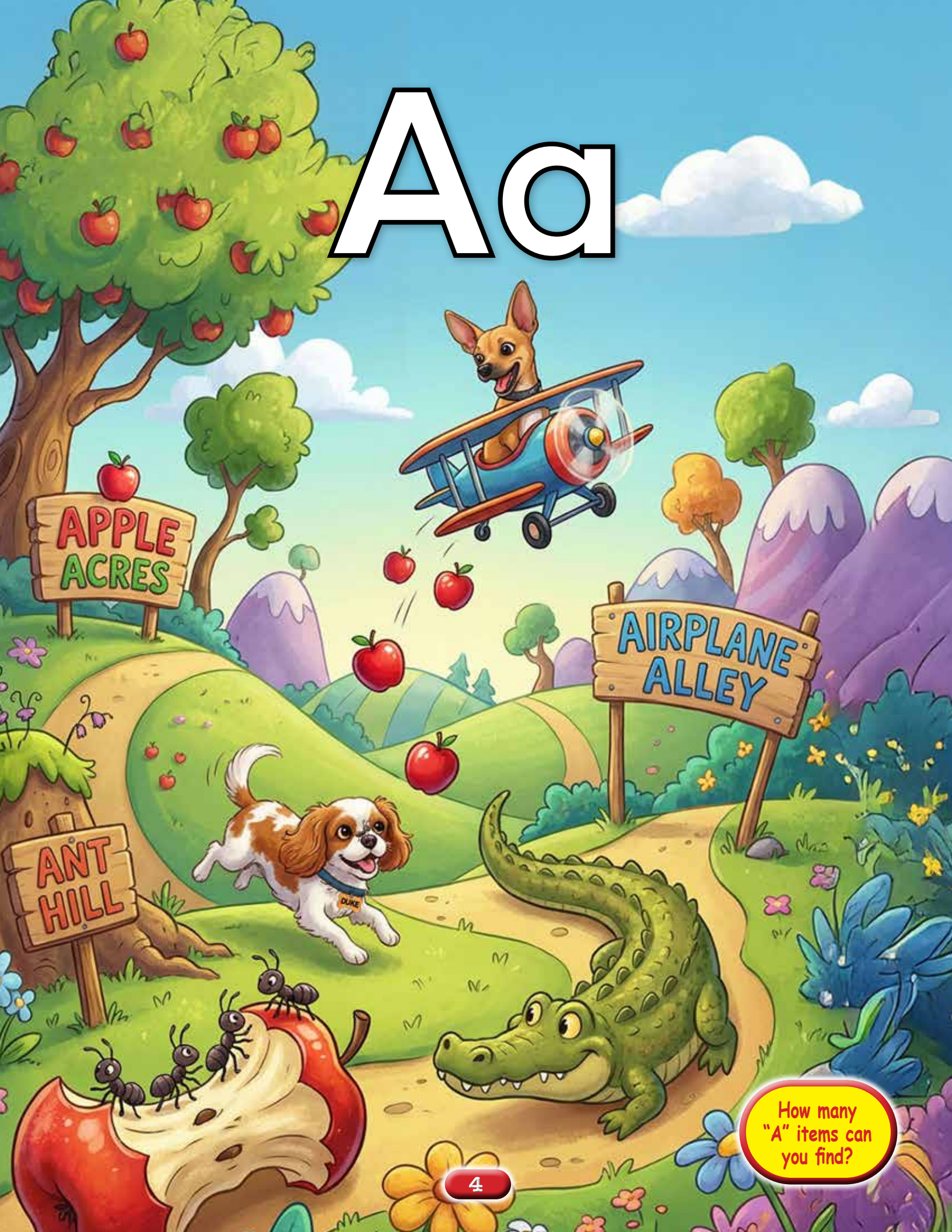

From **A** to **A** - they read it again.

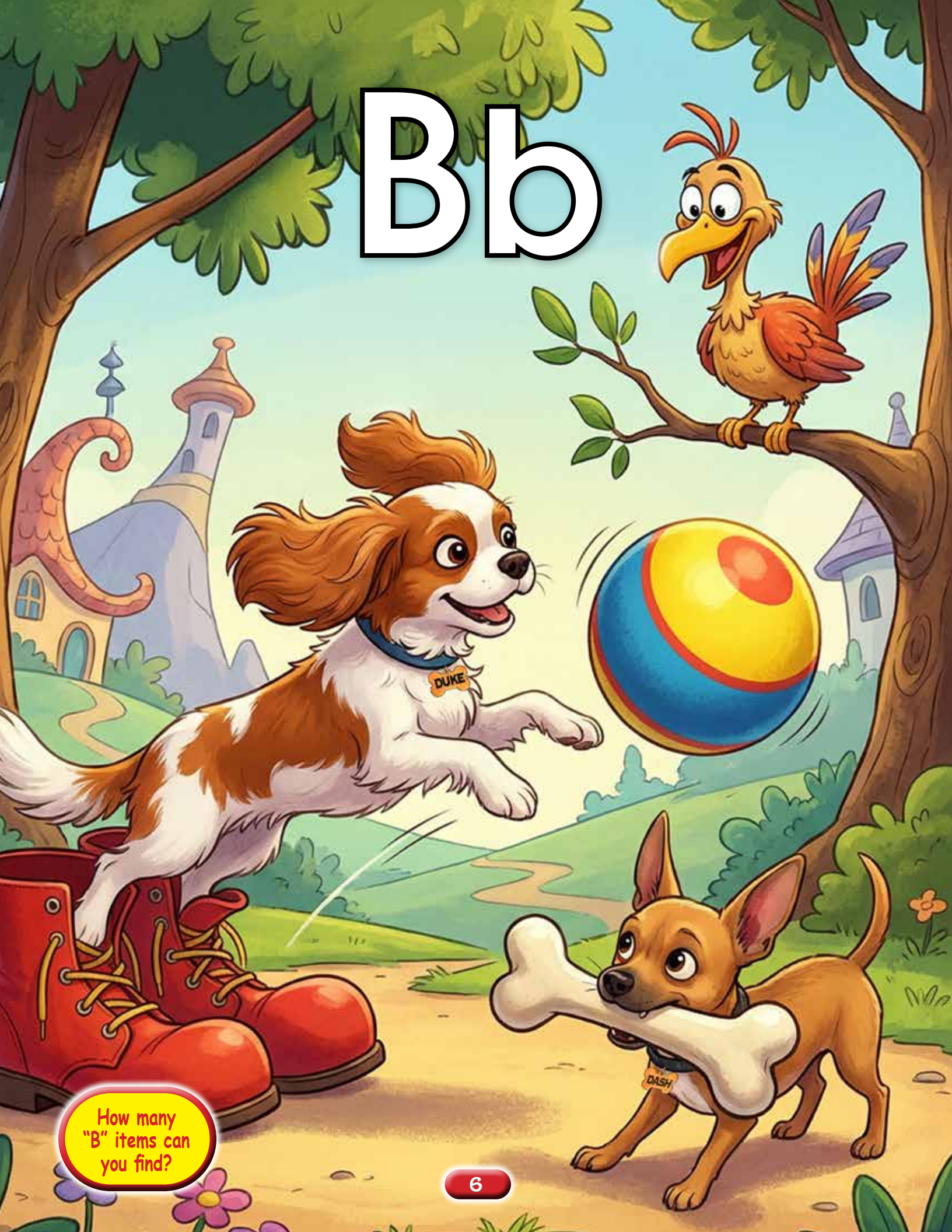
"**A** is amazing!" barked Dash.

"We're reading with letters," said Duke.

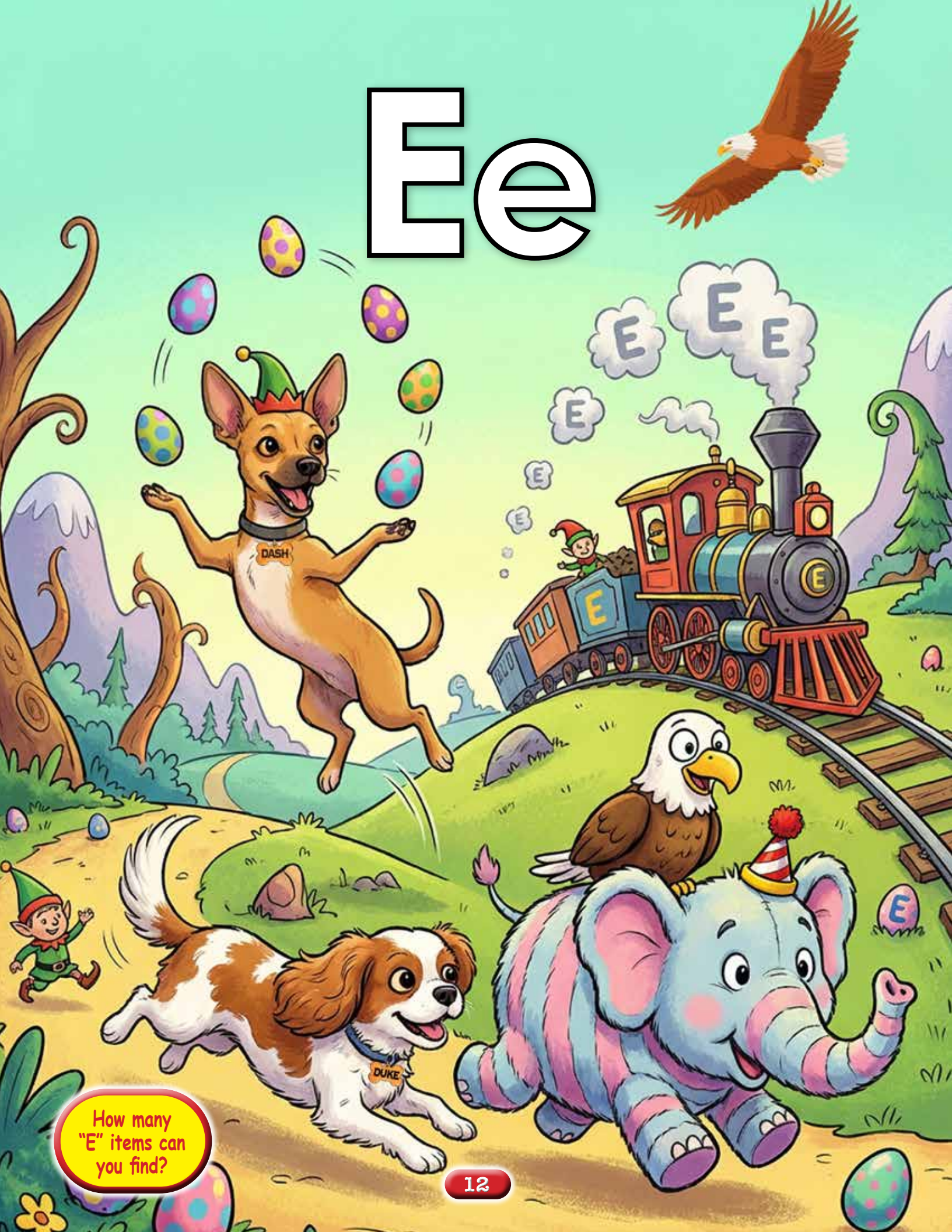
